

Changing display options in Explorer

This guide shows you 3 ways of changing display options when browsing websites with Explorer, making best use of a large screen projection.

For example, changing Explorer setting quickly transforms a web page into a literacy shared reading resource.

Instructions

To change text size on a web page

1. Open Internet Explorer
2. Click on **View** (top menu bar)
3. Click on **Text Size**
4. Select an appropriate size



Changing text size

To hide the toolbars

1. Press **F11** on your keyboard (top row)
To show it, press F11 again

To auto-hide the Standard buttons

1. Right-click in an empty grey area of the Standard buttons toolbar
2. Select **Auto-Hide**
3. To show, move mouse pointer to top of screen
